Peniel Holiness Camp hosts up to 75 teens, age 13 through 18. Our cost for 10 DAYS is ONLY \$75 for pre-registered youth, provided the registration is postmarked by Friday, July 13. The cost of registration at camp is \$100, or \$10 per day.


